## THE EVENT...

On Saturday, 15 June 2013 AMANDLA EduFootball (AEF), the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) and the Safety and Violence Initiative (University of Cape Town) will host 'Tackling Youth Violence', an event to commemorate Youth Day and discuss the serious impact that violence is having on Khayelitsha's youth. Young people, academics, practitioners & government representatives will attend this event, which will take place alongside AMANDLA's annual 24-hour Youth Day football event. This will create a dynamic platform to gain insight into the challenge of youth violence, to share success stories and build momentum to collaboratively 'tackle' youth violence in Khayelitsha.

## THE GOALS...

1. To locate the discussions around youth violence within Khayelitsha to allow those directly affected by violence to actively engage with academics, government officials and violence prevention practitioners on the causes of violence.
2. Allow youth to share their stories and propose solutions, and to highlight some of the positive youth development work already being pursued in Khayelitsha.
3. Develop networks between academics, practitioners, government officials, civil society organisations and individuals from violence-affected communities.
4. Inform the general public about the problem of youth violence and of prevention success stories.
